□ **Taylor-Johnson Temperament Analysis** or TJTA is published by Psychological Publications, Inc., in Los Angeles and was developed at the University of California in the 1950s and 1960s. It is widely used by consulting psychologists and pastoral counselors and has been administered to tens of thousands of men and women. The developers were Robert Taylor, long-time director of the Los Angeles Vocational Guidance Center and Russell Johnson, well-known professor of psychometrics.

□ **Leadership Practices Inventory** or LPI is published by Jossey-Bass/Pfeiffer and was developed by business school professors James Kouzes and Barry Posner. It measures fundamental patterns and habits related to effective leadership in business and other organizations. It has also been used with many thousands of men and women in leadership development programs, personal coaching, and business school classes.

**In this seminar we will administer both instruments and give you the complete results to keep, as well as take the time to fully explain what these data mean for you and your future. Therapists and coaches often do not release the full data, so this is one of the major benefits of this particular seminar.**

Testing results will be returned privately to each participant and a briefing to explain how to understand the data, as well as discussion of what various results mean, will be handled in the small group. **No one will be pushed to share any personal information.** Opportunities for private conversations will be provided.
